

**CITY OF MACCLENNY**  
**PUBLIC HEARING ON TENTATIVE BUDGET**  
**& PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE**  
**September 10, 2013**  
**5:30 P.M.**

The City Commission met in special session, Tuesday, September 10, 2013 with the following present: Mayor Gary Dopson, City Manager Phil Rhoden, and Commissioners Floyd V. Bennett, Richard Johnson, and Mark Bryant. Commissioner Tommy Johns was absent.

City Manager Phil Rhoden opened the meeting with prayer, followed by a pledge to the United States Flag.

Mayor Dopson stated that the purpose of this meeting is for the taxing authority to amend and adopt the tentative budget, re-compute its proposed millage rate, and publicly announce the percent, if any, by which the re-computed proposed millage exceeds the rolled-back rate. The proposed millage rate of 3.6000 is less than the rolled-back rate of 3.6541 mills by 1.48 percent.

Mayor Dopson read Resolution #13-05, a resolution of the City of Macclenny, of Baker County, Florida, adopting the tentative levy of ad valorem taxes for Baker County for fiscal year 2013-14 at a millage rate of 3.6000. The Council and audience had no questions. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Resolution #13-05 and was seconded by Commissioner Johnson. There were no questions. Voting was unanimous. Motion carried at 5:41 p.m.

Mayor Dopson read Resolution #13-06, a resolution of the City of Macclenny, adopting the tentative budget of \$7,168,268 for the fiscal year of 2013-14. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approved Resolution #13-06 and was seconded by Commissioner Johnson. There were no questions. Voting was unanimous. Motion carried at 5:42 p.m.

With no further business to come before the board, the budget meeting was adjourned.
