

**CITY OF MACCLENNY**  
**Special session**  
**September 11, 2012**  
**5:05 p.m.**

The City Commission met in special session, Tuesday, September 11, 2012 with the following present: Mayor Gary Dopson, City Manager Gerald Dopson, Commissioners Tommy Johns, Phil Rhoden, Richard Johnson and Floyd V. Bennett.

Mayor Dopson called the special session to order. City Manager Gerald Dopson opened the meeting with prayer, followed by a pledge to the United States Flag.

Mayor Dopson said the purpose of the meeting is for the taxing authority to amend and adopt the tentative budget, re-compute its proposed millage rate, and publically announce the percent, if any, by which the re-computed proposed millage exceeds the rolled-back rate. The Proposed millage rate of 3.6000 is less than the rolled back rate of 3.7033 mills by 2.79%.


First order of business is the approval of Resolution 12-04 adopting the tentative levy of ad valorem taxes including the operating millage rate of 3.60000. The City of Macclenny of Baker County set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the budget for Fiscal Year 2012/2013 in the amount of \$8,156,311. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Resolution 12-04. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous in favor by all Commissioners. Resolution 12-04 was duly adopted at 5:14 pm.

The second order of business was the approval of Resolution 12-05 adopting the tentative budget of \$8,156,311. Commissioner Bennett had a question as to where to find particular figures on the budget. Ms. Melissa Thompson was able to answer his questions. Discussion followed. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Resolution 12-05. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous in favor by all Commissioners. Resolution 12-05 was duly adopted at 5:20 pm.

With no further business, the special meeting was adjourned.
