

CITY OF MACCLENNY
PUBLIC HEARING ON FINAL BUDGET
& MILLAGE RATE
September 23, 2014
5:45 P.M.

The City Commission met in special session, Tuesday, September 23, 2014 with the following present: Mayor Gary Dopson, City Manager Phil Rhoden, and Commissioners Floyd V. Bennett, Sam Kitching, and Cecil Horne Jr., Mark Bryant was absent.

Mayor Dopson called the meeting to order. Commissioner Horne opened the meeting with prayer, followed by a pledge to the United States Flag.

Mayor Dopson stated that the purpose of this meeting is for the taxing authority to adopt the final budget and millage rate, and publicly announce the percent, if any, by which the re-computed millage exceeds the rolled-back rate. The millage rate of 3.6000 is less than the rolled-back rate of 3.5819 mills by .51 percent.

City Attorney Mr. Maloney read **Resolution 14-11**, a resolution of the City of Macclenny, of Baker County, Florida, adopting the final levy of ad valorem taxes for Baker County for fiscal year 2014-15 at a millage rate of 3.6000. Commissioner Kitching made a motion to approve Resolution 14-11 and was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. Motion carried at 5:48 p.m.

City Attorney Mr. Maloney read **Resolution 14-12**; a resolution of the City of Macclenny, of Baker County, Florida, adopting the final budget of \$10,627,357 for the fiscal year of 2014-15. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Resolution 14-12 and was seconded by Commissioner Kitching. There were no questions. Voting was unanimous. Motion carried at 5:50 p.m.

With no further business to come before the board, the budget meeting was adjourned.
