

CITY OF MACCLENNY
PUBLIC HEARING ON FINAL BUDGET
& MILLAGE RATE
September 22, 2015
5:05 P.M.

The City Commission met in special session, Tuesday, September 22, 2015 with the following present: Mayor Gary Dopson, City Manager Phil Rhoden, and Commissioners Floyd V. Bennett, Cecil Horne Jr., and Mark Bryant. Commissioner Kitching was absent.

Mayor Dopson called the meeting to order. Commissioner Bennett opened the meeting with prayer, followed by a pledge to the United States Flag.


Mayor Dopson stated that the purpose of this meeting is for the taxing authority to adopt the final budget and millage rate, and publicly announce the percent, if any, by which the re-computed millage exceeds the rolled-back rate. The millage rate of 3.6000 is less than the rolled-back rate of 3.6214 0mills by .59 percent.

City Attorney Mr. Maloney read **Resolution 15-12**, a resolution of the City of Macclenny, of Baker County, Florida, adopting the final levy of ad valorem taxes for Baker County for fiscal year 2015-16 at a millage rate of 3.6000. Commissioner Bryant made a motion to approve Resolution 15-12 and was seconded by Commissioner Bennett. Motion carried at 5:08 p.m.

City Attorney Mr. Maloney read **Resolution 15-13**; a resolution of the City of Macclenny, of Baker County, Florida, adopting the final budget of \$8,266,201 for the fiscal year of 2015-16. Commissioner Bennett made a motion to approve Resolution 15-13 and was seconded by Commissioner Bryant. There were no questions. Voting was unanimous. Motion carried at 5:09 p.m.

With no further business to come before the board, the budget meeting was adjourned.
