CITY OF MACCLENNY PUBLIC HEARING ON TENTATIVE BUDGET & PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE September 8, 2015

The City Commission met in special session, Tuesday, September 8, 2015 with the following present: Mayor Gary Dopson, City Manager Phil Rhoden, and Commissioners Cecil Horne Jr., Sam Kitching and Mark Bryant. Council Secretary Stacy Mills. Commissioner Floyd V. Bennett was absent

Commissioner Horne opened the meeting with prayer, followed by a pledge to the United States Flag.

Mayor Dopson stated the purpose of the meeting is for the taxing authority to amend and adopt the tentative budget, re-compute its proposed millage rate, and publicly announce the percent, if any, by which the re-computed proposed millage exceeds the rolled-back rate. The proposed millage rate of 3.6000 is less than the rolled-back rate of 3.6124 mills by .59%.

Mayor Dopson read **Resolution 15-08**. A Resolution of the City of Macclenny, of Baker County, Florida, adopting the tentative levy of ad valorem taxes for fiscal year 2015/16. No one stood up in opposition of this Resolution. Commissioner Kitching made a motion to approve **Resolution 15-08** and was seconded by Commissioner Bryant. Voting was unanimous. Motion carried at 5:56pm.

Mayor Dopson read **Resolution 15-09**. A Resolution of the City of Macclenny of Baker County, Florida, adopting the tentative budget for fiscal year 2015/16. The City of Macclenny set forth the appropriations and revenue estimate for the budget for fiscal year 2015/16 in the amount of 8,266,201. No one stood up in opposition of the tentative budget. Commissioner Kitching made a motion to approve **Resolution 15-09** and was seconded by Commissioner Bryant. Voting was unanimous. Motion carried at 5:58pm.

With no further business to come before the board, the budget meeting was adjourned.
